



# Travel recommendations to Heringsdorf

## By Car

The hotel offers a pricy private parking in the hotel garage or cheaper public parking around 300m from the hotel.

## By train

- You can go to Heringsdorf by train. For timetables and tickets please use the website of the German train company „Deutsche Bahn“: <https://int.bahn.de/en/>
- Most connections run via Berlin. From there you can use hourly connections to Heringsdorf. Trains need to be changed twice on that trip.

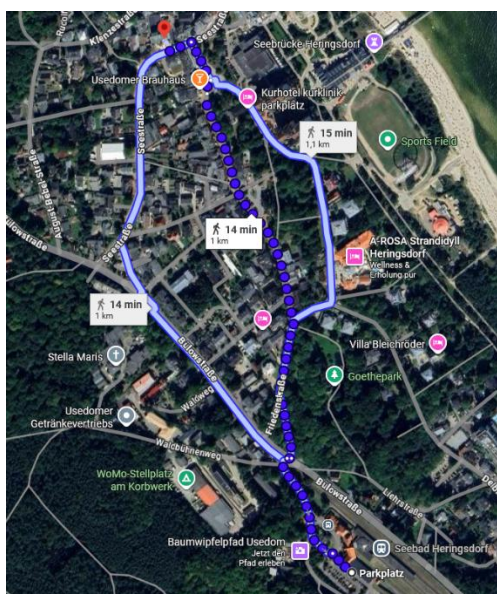
## By Airplane

### To/From Berlin

- When flying to Berlin there is the station directly at the airport ("Flughafen BER"), destination is "Seebad Heringsdorf".
- You can easily book online: <https://int.bahn.de/en/>
- Please be aware of the times when changing trains. Sometimes it is only 4 minutes but on the same platform. Trains commute every hour, so if you miss one, the next one will come soon.

### To/From Hamburg

- We do not recommend to fly via Hamburg, because at the moment there is construction work on the train connection between Hamburg and Rostock (that you will pass when travelling via Hamburg).
- The regional trains last double as long as normal, the fast trains go via Berlin.
- If you continue your travel from the airport by car, then Hamburg is an alternative



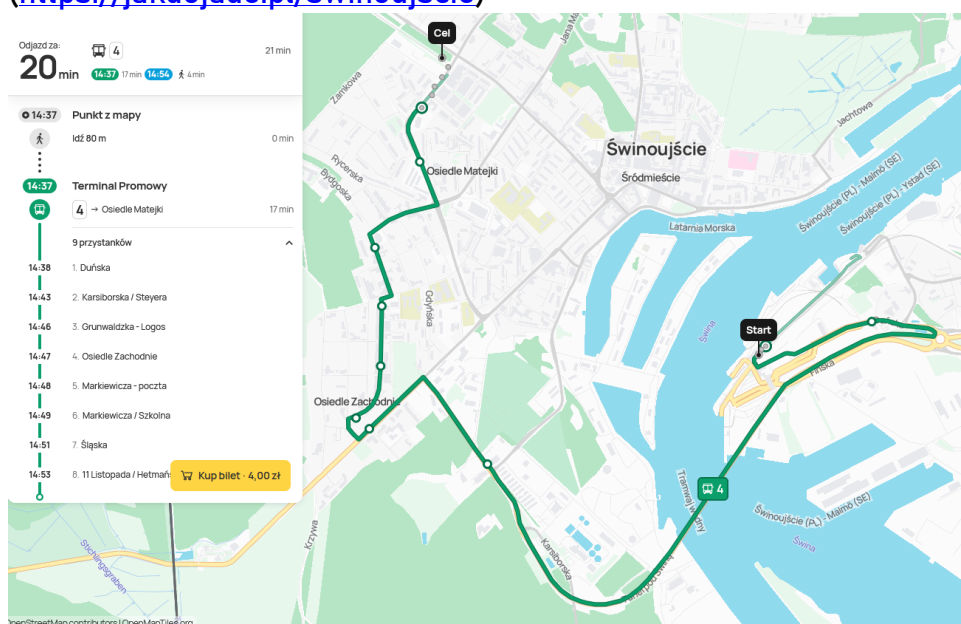
from the station „Seebad Heringsdorf“

# Travel recommendations to Heringsdorf

## By Ferry (from Sweden) to Świnoujście, Poland

- Trelleborg (TTLLine)
  - Malmö (Finnlines)
  - Ystad (Unity Line, Polferries)
- By bus from „Terminal Promowy“ (line 4) to Swinemünde station („11 Listopada - Dworzec UBB“)
- you can buy tickets for public transport in Świnoujście online (<https://jakdojade.pl/swinoujście>)



- at Świnoujście station you take the local train company UBB (blue) or the German Bahn (red) and within 10 minutes you will be in Heringsdorf
- there should be a ticket machine or shop at the station → the normal price for one trip/one person is 4.50 Euro; you can also buy a ticket in the train with extra service costs of 2 Euro
